Hospodar's charcuterie boards are sealed with natural mineral oil and a homemade beeswax sealant, which she sells and says is safe enough to use as a lip balm. Prices for her one-of-a-kind charcuterie boards, which come in a variety of lengths and thickness, range from \$35 to \$250.





"I use walnut, cherry and maple in my boards. We don't use any stains or dyes."
